1. (S) The following requirement was placed to Source: "A recent U. S. military defector, Sgt. Vladimir Sloboda, is now in the Soviet Union and reportedly dissatisfied. Is it possible that he will be permitted to return to U. S. jurisdiction? If so, under what conditions?"
2. (S) Source was shown a photograph of, and background information on, SLOBODA. Source said that he did not know SLOBODA and knew nothing of the case.
3. (S) With regard to the conditions under which the Soviets might release SLOBODA, Source said that they would not allow such a person to return to the U. S. unless he had been recruited by Soviet Intelligence.
