



D. Public Events - Ceremony of Inauguration

Opposition groups in government and anti-government will be called upon to utilize all the forces at their disposal to insure the President's safety while in Rio.

3. Maintenance Positive Action to be Taken by the Government

The local police, military, Labor, press, and foreign political exile groups, our representatives in Rio are planning to take maximum vigilance and use every available official resource to monitor and control the plans and activities of hostile groups and also to ascertain what measures designed to insure a favorable atmosphere for the Presidential visit.

E. General Remarks of Situation

At this time, the general security situation prevailing in Rio de Janeiro may be summarized. It is believed that the Local Forces - civilian and military - are capable of coping with any hostile demonstration or disturbance of persons or planes. At the time of the flight of former President Kennedy to Brazil in 1963, the Local Forces proved incapable of providing the security needed for the protection of the Presidential family in Rio. At the time of the return flight of President Castro in August 1963, the local forces again failed their ability to cope with hostile crowds and aircraft demonstrators. The good will generated by the friendly reception of President Kennedy on his recent trip to the United States will be a factor in insuring a similar reception for President Kennedy. It is expected that the Brazilian official attitude towards the visit will be highly favorable and that this in turn will contribute towards a similar attitude on the part of the press and the public.

A. PREPARATION FOR A BATTLE AGAINST THE FLAHT

(1) PREPARATION FOR THE FLAHT

As previously reported to you, the PCC (17,500 members in San Pedro State) have already initiated steps to implement their determination to use the traditional strike. In spite of the fact that the majority of the advanced groups refuse to endorse the idea, it can be expected in time the PCC movement will be inclined to support publicly against the FLAHT. The PCC will want to carry militarily against the FLAHT in the local Chiquist state, notably in Morelos. The official PCC press will, however, and probably initially, emphasize its influence and its own resolution to oppose the FLAHT. Heavy appeals will probably be made to the local middle class and other workers. The Morelos PCC will undoubtedly emphasize one of the forms used by previous advanced peasant groups, their organization into the Morelos Peasant Councils, and the Morelos Peasant Federation of Mexico. Perhaps the most important of the PCC in this regard will be the local labor unions under the control such as the family nucleus unions, agricultural workers unions, teachers' unions, etc., civil servants' unions, miners, food workers unions, and the several maritime unions. Groups of miners which the Peasant National Conference [] (1959) (Morelos Peasant), can also be expected to participate more and more in battle action.

(2) COMMUNIST PARTIES OF CHIAPAS (PCC) AND MORELOS (PCM)

As previously explained, the PCC is a Marxist-Leninist Party with a predominantly peasant base and could be expected to continue and expand very significantly. It would have little to do or say in relation to the well known PCC's opposition to the FLAHT. By the time when the Morelos PCM can be relied upon to support any and all forms of resistance against the FLAHT, the PCC will be large. As the most radical forces in the Morelos area, the PCC and the PCM will probably support violent forms of struggle of the type of those adopted by the PCC during their fight to Venezuela in the years 1952-53. Although both of these parties are small and relatively weak they still in conjunction with existing extreme rightwing elements by means violent, but lawful, demonstrations.

(3) RADICAL PARTIES




