That copy lobtained by CIA unofficially from contact in Mexican Presidency

Through MEX-56 who is close relative and confident/ to President Diaz Ordaz arrangements being made for official confirmation of receipt of cablegram. *MEX-562 will ascertain afrom President, Tuesday, 6/18/68, when President is available, whether some representative of Presidency can be designated to act as witness to testify to receipt of cablegram if necessary. / K Xu)
