ARE ALL ARMED FORCES WHO REFUSE TO GO AHEAD WITH THE COUP.

THERE ARE SEVERAL HUNDRED MERCHANTS GATHERED IN GUATEMALA, NICARAGUA, AND
 HEADQUARTERS COMMENT: IN EARLY MARCH 1964, [REDACTED] (S)
 [REDACTED] THAT ARISMENDE TRUJILLO HAS REPORTEDLY PLANNING TO RECRUIT MERCHANTS
 ACROSS NICARAGUA, NICARAGUA, AND GUATEMALA AND TRANSPORT THEM TO HAITI FOR AN INVAS-
 ION OF THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC WHEN AN AERIAL SIGNAL FROM DOMINICAN MILITARY OFFICERS
 TO THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC WAS RECEIVED. [REDACTED] REFER-
 RED IN MID-MAY 1964 THAT ARISMENDE TRUJILLO; PEDRO V. TRUJILLO MOLINA, BROTHER OF
 ARISMENDE; PEDRO TRUJILLO NICOLAS, SON OF PEDRO; AND PAULINO A. SIERRA MARTINEZ,
 A CUBAN EXILE NOW IN GUATEMALA, HAVE TALKED OF LEAVING GUATEMALA FOR NICARAGUA TO CON-
 TACT MARCEL ARTIME BURSA, LEADER OF THE CUBAN EXILE ORGANIZATION MOVIMIENTO DE RENOVACION
 ACCION REVOLUCIONARIA (MRR - MOVEMENT FOR REVOLUTIONARY RECOVERY), TO DISCUSS THE CUBAN
 BEHAVIOR; THE TRUJILLOS WOULD THEN TRY TO HAVE TO ORGANIZE 2,000 MEN WHO ARE
 WILLING TO JOIN THE CUBAN EXILES IN AN REVOLUTIONARY EFFORT OF CUBA. [REDACTED] THAT
 ARTIME WAS ASKED ARISMENDE TRUJILLO SEVERAL TIMES TO GET IN TOUCH WITH HIM. ARISMENDE
 TO DATE. TRUJILLO HE IS SURE THAT HE CAN COUNT ON AT LEAST 2,000 MEN AND THAT PROBABLY
 HE CAN RECRUIT MORE.)

1. THE GUATEMALAN GOVERNMENT WILL SOON ASK ARISMENDE TO LEAVE GUATEMALA, AS A
 RESULT OF A REQUEST RECEIVED FROM THE DOMINICAN FOREIGN MINISTRY. ARISMENDE WILL THEN
 TRY TO ENTER NICARAGUA OR HAITI, NEITHER OF WHICH WILL GRANT HIM A VISA. ARISMENDE
 WILL THEN RETURN TO SPAIN. (HEADQUARTERS COMMENT: ON 2 APRIL 1964, THE NICARAGUAN
