captioned "Schedule for a Comandos L Raid on Puerto Padre, Cuba,"
both of which are self-explanatory. (S) (U)

For your confidential information, not to be disseminated
outside the Bureau, information has been received from CIA
indicating that pursuant to instructions from the White House,
CIA is currently exploring the possibilities of collaborating
with this organization in promoting activities directed against
the Castro government. This will include raids on Cuba. All
such raids would be initiated from British territory in the
Bahamas and it will be necessary for [redacted]

Immediately check with CIA to see if CIA has operational
interest in raid set forth in referenced communications. If no
CIA interest, check with Customs to determine if it is investigating
this matter. (S) (U)

In event neither factor is present, promptly check
sources and informants for any indication there is substance to
the allegation and keep Bureau currently advised of all developments.
