[On February 15, 1965, MI T-1, another Government agency which conducts intelligence investigations, furnished] a copy of a letter, dated December 7, 1964, at Miami, Florida, from Oscar C. de Tuya, Jr., Executive Vice President, Tuya Cuban Express, P. O. Box 48-51, International Airport, Miami, Florida, addressed to The

[redacted] Milwaukee, Wisconsin. This letter notes that the company to which it was addressed had for several years, favored Tuya Cuban Express with air shipments to Cuba, and that operations of Tuya Cuban Express were discontinued in 1960, due to the communist take-over and the imprisonment of the writer and his father. The letter continues that "Today, we are engaged in the struggle against communism through 'Comandos L', and I come to ask for your support". The letter asks for spiritual support and financial aid, stating that a contribution would help provide "the solid financial backing needed to wage our war against communism, today firmly entrenched only 90 miles from your shores". (S)(u)

[MI T-1 also furnished] a copy of a form, which accompanied above letter, to be completed by contributors and mailed with contributions to either the Tuya Cuban Express, P. O. Box 51, International Airport Branch, Miami, Florida 33148 or to Comandos "L", P. O. Box 66, Riverside Station, Miami, Florida 33135. This form, states "We wish to contribute the amount of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ to help you continue your fight against the communist regime that oppresses Cuba and threatens the security of our continent. ---." It also leaves space for contributors to note whether they desire to make a monthly contribution or a single contribution, and to signify if they are interested in being placed on a mailing list for more information about Comandos "L". It is noted at the bottom of this form that Comandos "L" is a non-profit organization. (S)(u)
