Information developed by a sensitive source of the Washington Field Office has indicated that one Rudy Gomez possibly a U. S. Government employee, had been in contact with Lieutenant Commander Miguel Pons, Naval Attache, Embassy of Cuba, Washington, D. C. The Liaison Agent was instructed to determine if Gomez was connected with CIA. (S)(U)

Rudy Gomez, an intelligence officer employed by CIA for the last several years, is personally known to the Liaison Agent. Gomez has served for CIA in Spain, Cuba, and Argentina. He is currently assigned to CIA headquarters, Washington, D. C. On March 24, 1959, A. P. Flynn, CIA, advised the Liaison Agent that as a result of his service in Cuba Gomez does know several Cuban Government officials. Flynn stated that Gomez has been in touch with Lieutenant Commander Pons, whom he has known for several years, and that the contact in Washington, D. C., was strictly of a social nature. Flynn advised that Gomez is not involved in any intelligence operation with the Cubans. (S)

Although Flynn did not volunteer any more information, it is very possible that Gomez, as other CIA intelligence officers, is endeavoring to build up coverage in Cuba after losing sources when the Batista Government was overthrown. Gomez may be renewing old contacts with a view of obtaining leads for new sources in Cuba. (U)
