This Agency was recently in receipt of information from on Subject which may be of interest to the addressees. 15/

is as follows

Subject was born on 5 August 1910 in the Province of Castalon, Spain, the son of Miguel and Teresa, who then had a permanent residence in Monrovia, Liberia. He carries a Spanish National Identity document #36989561; place of issuance illegible. It is reported that Subject was formerly a Colonel in the American Air Force but lost his retirement pension from the UBAF because of his work as an Air Force instructor in Venezuela during the reign of Marcos Perez Jimenez. is divorced and has a son residing in Canada, also a pilot in the USAF.

Subject, who is presently residing in the Canary Islands, drew attention to himself when it was revealed he carried both Spanish and "North American" passports. He appeared to have plenty of money but lived alone and avoided all social contact.

If there is any information on Subject in the files of the addresseds, it would be appreciated if it would be forwarded to this Agency.
