approved no attempt be made to develop Gibson as informant.
CIA was advised of subject's willingness to cooperate and CIA
advised consideration would be given to utilize Gibson on an
intelligence mission inside Cuba.

Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) previously informed us that consideration was being given to possibly utilizing the subject in Cuba. (S) Gibson is known to us for his past involvement in the activities of the Free Play for Cuba Committee. (S)

On December 14, 1962, Austin Horne, CIA, advised the Liaison Agent that his agency had discontinued its interest in the subject. (S)
