The source further stated that the above information was furnished to him on 4/30/67 at which time Rodriguez Tamayo said he needed the detonators by 5 p.m. on 5/1/67 as two unnamed American citizens would be taking the explosives and detonators to Canada

contact with Rodriguez Tamayo who indicated he had been unable to obtain the additional detonators and said it was "too late anyway," possibly indicating the two Americans had already departed. felt perhaps Rodriguez Tamayo may have been merely boasting concerning this matter

In view of the seriousness of the allegation, we disseminated Simmediately by teletype to State, CIA, Secret-Service and the military. We telephonically furnished the information to Legal for dissemination to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Attache: Ottawa.
