Sources in Tshombe's office are close mouthed regarding report originating that Tshombe plans leave this week to mee U Thant in Europe or New York. CAS has report that as of late July 9 Tshombe planned leave on or immediately after July 11 Independence cermonies. Tshombe is quoted as saying Brigadier Rikhye extended invitation on behalf U Thant.

Rikhye gave me opposite impression, i.e. Thant unlikely receive Tshombe at this stage. One observer believes that Tshombe may be using this gimmick as cover for trip to Europe to look discreetly into Du Farron's reported betrayal which if known could compromise Tshombe seriously (Brussels telegram 34 to Department).
