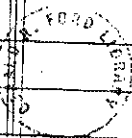

Thinks he travelled to India 1 or 2  
times per year, 2 or 3 times to Paris  
& 1-2 times per year in London,  
& 1 or less times per yr in Rome.  
Only domestic travel in 63 wd have  
been to NY. All travel done  
in his own name. ~~except~~

On 22 Nov. '63, he & wife were driving  
on H St & 9th in Wash. D.C.  
when heard on car radio. Had  
been in Chinese grocery store.  
On way home to 5215 Baltor Rd,  
Summer, Md. Drove home after  
stopping at Sidwell <sup>Friends</sup> School &  
picked up <sup>Upper Wisconsin Ave</sup> younger daughter Kevan  
Hunt. Robert & Courtney

Kevan remembers that Robt Kennedy's  
children, in same school, had  
been picked up from school by Secret  
Service & the children knew abt  
assass.
