- Undated, unmarked (except for -572 Moscow, Enclosure 1) report of visit to Mrs. Sloboda in Nov. - to inquire, on behalf of Consular Section, about progress of visa application for their son.

- Source doc. (8/7/60) indicates S's defection; info. that ops officer believes subj. had very limited access to 513 MITG files or operations.

- Several docs. (dated Aug. - Nov. (1960)) re S's access to class. info, knowledge of persons serving in specific intell. ops.

- 8/10/60 Green List Check - indicates no info. on S in FI/D.

- 5/22/62 Dispatch, Chief SR, via Chief WE to [redacted] re list of questions for Mrs. Sloboda who left husband in USSR & ret. to London.

No response in file as to efforts to question Mrs. S.

- Chronology indicates wife was interviewed by [redacted] ²⁴ on 3/19/63

- 4/19/63 Dispatch, [redacted] to Chief, SR & Chief, NE; RE: ~~well~~ attached report of 3/19/63 interview w/ Mrs. S.

- Denied that she was recruited by Sov. intell. or ever approached by them.

- ~~Halperin~~ file begins with employment records during 1940's.
- Indicates that during his employment w/ OSS in Wash., D.C., Halperin was passing inf. to Jacob GOLOS, a known Soviet espionage agent. Apparently, FBI was handling case until time in late 1953, when Halperin left U.S. for Mexico.
- 201 file requests on M. H. Halperin and Edith Friedl Halperin are dated 9/3/57 and 9/24/56, respectively. Files indicate heavy [telephonic surveillance] on Halperins during 1957 & 1958.
- Files also contain copies of correspondence to Halperins.
- Left Mexico in 1958
- Lived in Soviet Union from 12/58 until 10/62, when they moved to Cuba
- + ~~Revised~~ Employed as professor at Simon Fraser U. in Vancouver
