MOVIMIENTO RECUPERACION REVOLUCIONARIO (MRR) REGISTRATION ACT - CUBA

On June 14, 1963, MANUEL ARTIME BUESA, 6151 S.W. 16th Terrace, Miami, Florida, advised he was formerly a Doctor and Rebel Army Officer in Guna, and is now head of the Movimiento Recuperacion Revolucionario (MRK), a Cuban anti-Communist organization, dedicated to the overthrow of the present government of Cuba.

ARTIME stated his organization continues to carry on its infiltration and clandestine operations against Cuba, but is not engaged in any military attacks against the coast of Cuba or Russian shipping.

ARTIME said that since his return to the United States in December, 1952, the MRR has participated in missions to Cuba, with the authorization of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA).

ARTINE advised that on his trip through Central America in May, 1963, he visited several of the Central American countries, conferred with high government officials and was favorably received. Cooperation and military bases were offered to him. ARTINE said the President of one Central American country commented that ARTINE is the first Cuban who had talked to him who did not come asking for money.

ARTIME said he expects that cooperation and military bases in Central America will be forthcoming, and this aid will in no way conflict with the United States government policy concerning Cuba, or United States government relations with the several Central American republics.
