On March 3, 1964, GERMINAL MONGE LAZCURES, Section Chief, Immigration Department, San Jose, Costa Rica, advised from his records that GEORGE DE MOHRENSCHILDT and JEANNE DE MOHRENSCHILDT, traveling on United States passport #2186601, issued June 10, 1960, in the United States, entered Costa Rica on June 6, 1961, from Panama and departed Costa Rica on July 18, 1961, for Nicaragua (mode of travel not indicated).
