On 5/23/63, WILLIAM BULLOCK, elevator operator, 525 Park Avenue, NYC, residence of PHYLLIS MC GUIRE, advised he has not seen subject recently. He believes CHRISTINE and DOROTHY MC GUIRE have moved into the Regency House Hotel. (u)

Mr. VON KRETSCHMANN, Assistant Manager, Regency House Hotel, advised Mr. and Mrs. LOWELL WILLIAMSON (DOROTHY MC GUIRE), 340 Bentall Building, Calgary, Canada, registered on 5/21/63 and were assigned Room 1016. CHRISTINE MC GUIRE registered on 5/21/63 and was assigned Room 1002. WILLIAMSON is expected to leave on 5/24/63 and the girls on 6/10/63. (u)

On 5/24/63, PCI LOWELL WILLIAMSON was interviewed in the NYO. It was pointed out that the FBI is not investigating the MC GUIRE sisters but did have an investigation concerning subject. WILLIAMSON stated he understood this and will be glad to cooperate with the FBI. He will keep the contact with the FBI confidential. (u)

WILLIAMSON stated he knows from newspaper publicity GIANCANA is a hoodlum and can only damage the reputation of the MC GUIRES. He said GIANCANA came to NYC with them from Pittsburgh on 5/19/63 and left for Chicago on either 5/20/63 or 5/21/63. (u)

Concerning the recent travels of GIANCANA, WILLIAMSON said following the appearance of the MC GUIRE sisters in Vancouver, B. C., in the end of April, GIANCANA came to his home in Calgary, Canada, with the sisters. GIANCANA and PHYLLIS stayed for three or four days and then went to Los Angeles and Palm Springs, California, where PHYLLIS had a part in FRANK SINATRA's movie "Come Blow Your Horn." (u)

GIANCANA then left PHYLLIS and went to Hawaii with SINATRA and PHYLLIS went on to Pittsburgh. SINATRA is reportedly having trouble with IRS, not being able to show how he earned all the money he is spending. LUCILLE BALL (actress) is supposed to have introduced SINATRA to a very wealthy widow, name unknown, from Hawaii and SINATRA is considering marrying her to account for the money he is spending. (u) CALIF.

PHYLLIS did not know GIANCANA was going to Hawaii and became furious with him and called him and he joined the MC GUIRE sisters in Pittsburgh. From Pittsburgh they all came to NYC. While in NYC, GIANCANA stayed in PHYLLIS' apartment. (u)

WILLIAMSON advised the next engagement for the sisters is 6/9/63 on the ED SULLIVAN TV show and then 6/13/63-6/22/63 at "The Monticello", Framington, Massachusetts. (u)

WILLIAMSON said GIANCANA usually has plenty of money with him and he has never seen him being given any money. GIANCANA has a one-suiter suitcase which he carries with him. (u)

VIC COLLINS is a general handyman employed by the sisters and is presently staying at the Madison Hotel, NYC. (u)

WILLIAMSON advised he is leaving NYC alone either 5/25/63 or 5/26/63. He will recontact the agents when he returns to NYC and if GIANCANA made any calls from his home in Calgary he will furnish the numbers called to the agents. (u)
