WEEKLY SUMMARY

On 5/27/63, WILLIE MAE JACKSON, PCI, (PROTECT), advised subject was home, 2505 Bristol Ave., on 5/25/63, when source was last at such residence, and source obtained no indication subject leaving immediately. Source advised subject does not discuss personal affairs and was of opinion Mr. and Mrs. TRAFFICANTE, particularly Mrs., would be around her home during May and June because of the impending wedding of SARAH ANN.

On 5/27/63, JAMES W. DONOFRIO, PCI, (PROTECT), advised subject was definitely not in the presence of JAMES W. DONOFRIO when DONOFRIO ate at the Palms Restaurant, 5/22/63, which establishment is run by JOE BEDAMI. Source said BEDAMI went up to DONOFRIO and talked with him, but there was no indication SANTO TRAFFICANTE had been at the establishment.

On 5/27/63, J. H. MC BRIDE and MARY MOTT, National Airlines, downtown ticket office, advised after a check of records, that SANTO TRAFFICANTE had not used any National Airlines transportation using his own name since 5/1/63.

On the same date, JULIAN ACOSTA, National Airlines, and JOE CRENSHAW, Eastern Airlines, Tampa International Airport, both of whom know subject, advised subject had not been seen using any of their flights.

On 5/27/63, Deputy LOWELL STEVE, Sheriff's Office, advised he observed subject, SAM TRAFFICANTE, JIMMY LONGO, and AUGUST PANIELLO at the Columbia Restaurant. At about 9:00 PM the foursome left the Columbia and went directly to 2505 Bristol Avenue, and a check of the residence at midnight disclosed that SAM TRAFFICANTE, JIMMY LONGO and subject were in subject's living room watching television.

PETE AYALA, Airport Police, on 5/28/63, advised he knew subject and his body guard, JIMMY LONGO, but that he had not seen them in a couple of months at the airport. He said a car would drive up and leave an individual off and the car would then drive off, and he was of the opinion LONGO drove subject to the airport on occasions.

On 5/28/63, WILLIE MAE JACKSON, PCI, advised SANTO TRAFFICANTE was home on 5/27/63, and that when SANTO TRAFFICANTE was told that the FBI had been in numerous contacts with his maid, SANTO told the maid that she did not have to talk to the FBI, and that she should have nothing to do with the FBI agents.

At 1:15 PM, PETE AYALA telephonically advised SA LABADIE that subject was on TWA flight leaving the airport at 1:15 PM and he did not know the flight number. TWA advised the flight leaving Tampa International Airport at 1:15 PM was TWA flight number 550 due to arrive at Miami at 2:19 PM. The Miami Office was telephonically advised of the above information at 1:21 PM.
