A confidential source advised that approximately three weeks ago Phil Alderisio asked him if he would accompany him, (Alderisio), to Florida. Alderisio, on this occasion advised that this source would be well paid if he made this trip and would also be well paid if he should "Get to the right people in Florida". This source stated that Alderisio was referring to a banker known as James W. Egan in Florida who has "Alderisio over a barrel". This source stated that Alderisio by his comments meant that some force should be used against the banker, such as breaking a leg or arm, which would prevent him from testifying against Alderisio.

This confidential source stated that he "turned down" Alderisio's request inasmuch as he was afraid to get deeply involved with him in his activities.

This confidential source added that Alderisio is a violent and vicious man, who would not permit anyone to stand in/his way.
