WEEKLY AIRTEL SUMMARY

On 6/6/62, subject was observed to visit the Eastern Airlines (EAL) Administration Building, Miami International Airport (MIA), Miami, Fla. Investigation determined subject attempted to contact Mr. JOSEPH SPOTO PITISCI who is Superintendent of Engine Overhaul, EAL. PITISCI advised on 6/7/62, that he is originally from Tampa and his step-mother's brother is PAUL LONGO, who is married to subject's aunt. PITISCI advised he left Tampa in 1931 and has been employed by EAL for 33 years. He said he last saw subject 10 years ago at the funeral of PITISCI's father. PITISCI advised he attended a wedding in Tampa two weeks ago and told subject's brother, FRANK TRAFFICANTE, who was also there, where he was located in Miami. PITISCI advised after returning from a meeting in the afternoon of 6/6/62, his secretary told him he had a caller named "SANTO", who apparently had not waited as he did not see the subject on that date.

CARLOS ALVAREZ, PSI (protect), advised on 5/23/62, that he had observed subject's car at the Fontainebleau Hotel, Miami Beach, early on the morning of 5/22/62. He said on the night of 5/21/62, and morning of 5/22/62, he had observed numerous known gamblers, (including (FNU) BRADY, who is frequently seen with the subject, JOE FISCHETTI, TONY RANDAZZO, HARRY SNOW and MAX RAYMOND.

Tax Records, Hialeah, Fla. City Hall, reflect FRANK LAGANO, 308 Tampa St., Tampa, Fla., purchased the property at 657 West 34th St., Hialeah, from SALVATORE G. SCALIA on 1/18/61.

City of Miami telephone Directory contains no person named SALVATORE G. SCALIA.

JAMES DUCA interviewed on 5/24/62, in connection with another investigation, advised he and the subject are old friends having been raised together in Tampa, Fla. He said the subject recently told him the FBI would never put him in jail, but they were going to "worry him to death".
