Columbia Restaurant in company of JAMES C. LONGO.

On 7/5/62 JACK de la LLANA, Intelligence Unit Tampa PD advised DUANE BRADFORD, reporter, "Tampa Tribune", advised him on 7/5/62 that the newspaper had allegedly received an anonymous long distance telephone call from a Latin voice to the effect that the subject was delayed in getting a plane out of Miami International Airport on July 2 or 3, 1962, further stating subject would be flying into Tampa later. de la LLANA said BRADFORD claimed that he went to airport to cover subject's arrival but subject was not observed to arrive in Tampa at the Tampa International Airport.

de la LLANA advised another source, considered reliable, told him subject spent all day 7/4/62 at the TRAFFICANTE family beach property, St. Petersburg Beach, Florida.

It was ascertained on 7/5/62 from FRANK HURLEY (PROTECT), who handles the real estate property of the TRAFFICANTE family at St. Petersburg Beach, that Mrs. SANTO TRAFFICANTE was known to have been at the beach property on July 4 and indicated to sources that she was having company on July 4.

CS TP 51-C made available information on 7/5/62 that the subject at 2505 Bristol Avenue, Tampa was notified by the Central Bank of Tampa, Tampa, Florida, 6/26/62 that a note in favor of the bank will be due on 6/30/62, the principal on the note indicated as \$17,250.06.

It is noted CASIMIRO HERNANDEZ, JR., owner of the Columbia Restaurant, a usual hang-out for subject when in Tampa, died July 6, 1962, however, no arrangements for funeral have been arranged as yet.
