WEEKLY AIRTEL SUMMARY

Report of SA STEPHEN J. LABADIE dated 6/23/62 at Tampa set out that a call was made from subject's unlisted phone at Tampa, Florida, to Louisville 502366-5594 on April 19, 1962. The Louisville Office advised the subscriber of this number is SANDY PANIELLO, a lawyer whose clients are various and sundry gamblers in the Louisville, Kentucky area. (It is noted subject's son-in-law is AUGUST PANIELLO, and he resides at 2505 Bristol, Tampa.)

Report of SA STEPHEN J. LABADIE dated April 24, 1962 at Tampa set out information that subject used to hang out in New York City at Mary's Restaurant, and New York Office has advised that no information was developed in this regard, nor has it been developed that ALBERT ANASTASIA ever hung out at Mary's Restaurant, which is located in Greenwich Village and which has been reported as a hangout for homosexuals. New York advised no information was ever reported that a "lady in red" was at New York race tracks, and there was no record of a NORMA BRIDGES for the last few years at the Carlyle Hotel. WILLIE PEP is no longer connected with Melody Lane, and the Melody Lane Bar has been closed.

Subject was reported by Deputy Sheriff HENRY JUSTO, Sheriff's Office, on July 6, 1962, as staying at 3612 El Centro, St. Petersburg Beach, Florida. He also reported cars utilized by SAM TRAFFICANTE were at 3610 El Centro, which addresses are those of the TRAFFICANTE beach property at St. Petersburg Beach, Florida. It was noted the white Chevrolet Impala, bearing 1962 Florida license 3W 12736 was noted at the beach.

DOMINICK LAROCA, PCI (Protect), reported subject as being at the Columbia Restaurant, Tampa, on the night of July 5, 1962, in the company of JIMMY LONGO, and source reports subject has not been back to the Columbia since that date.

1959 Chevrolet Impala, 1962 Florida license 3W 12736, observed in driveway at 2505 Bristol Avenue July 11 and 12, 1962; however, subject has not been observed at residence.

Other sources, such as CS TP 51-C and informants, as well as Intelligence Unit, Tampa PD, have not reported subject's presence in Tampa.

ROBERT TINNARO, Central Bank of Tampa, Tampa, Florida (Protect), advised July 12, 1962 that an unidentified young, white, red haired female again made the mortgage payment for note at 2505 Bristol Avenue on July 12, 1962.
