It is noted that New York is continuing to contact New York informants knowledgable of LCN matters and New York is attempting to develop information concerning Howard Amusement shows at Middletown and Syosset, New York.

IMAIM

AT MIAMI, FLORIDA

Will recontact MM 1399-PC if feasible re whereabouts of MANOCCHIO it being noted that this informant placed MANOCCHIO in New Jersey on 11/1/69.

BOSTON

AT BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS:

Will recontact BS 1159-C-TE, who formerly had contact with both MANOCCHIO and VENDITUOLI.

AT PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND

Will recontact relatives of subjects in Rhode Island and will conduct other logical investigation to locate subjects.

ADMINISTRATIVE

Regular contacts were made during this investigative period with CI's and PCI's and C-TE's of the Boston Office concerning subjects MANOCCHIO and VENDITUOLI with negative results.

It is noted that the investigative period of this report overlaps that of pervious reports in order to report the results of investigation conducted in other divisions which was not available at the time previous reports were written.

On February 24, 1971, Boston PC JOAN CRANE, advised SA MARTIN P. CONLEY that RUDOLPH SCIARRA will seek to establish an alibi at the forthcoming trial for the MELEI and MARFEO murders. SCIARRA will use a priest

and a doctor to testify that SCIARRA was with them and therefore not with "RED" KELLY at the times that KELLY plotted with SCIARRA at the Gateway Motel.

RUDOLPH SCIARRA and his wife, LUCY, are angry with BOBBY FAIRBROTHERS and his wife for not supporting them and therefore the SCIARRA's and the FAIRBROTHER's are not presently on speaking terms.

It is noted that federal indictments remain pending in captioned matter only against subjects, MANOCCHIO and VENDITUOLI.

On 12/8/70, U.S. District Court, Judge ANDREW CAFFREY, Boston, Mass., granted the Government's motion to dismiss the Federal indictments against RAYMOND L.S. PATRIARCA, RUDOLPH SCIARRA, JOHN ROSS, MAURICE LERNER and ROBERT FAIRBROTHER. The government requested this dismissal since these 5 individuals had previously been convicted of conspiracy to murder under Rhode Island law.
