Synopsis: Subject resides with his wife at 340 Haven Avenue, Apartment 5S, NYC, and is enrolled at Teachers College, Columbia University, 525 West 120th Street, in the current semester as a candidate for a doctorate. In June, 1967, through his wife, subject refused to be interviewed by Immigration And Naturalization Service (INS) at NYC. Subject's identification record set forth. Confidential informants familiar with Cuban activities, in November, 1967, advised subject unknown to them.

DETAILS

On November 21, 1967, Mr. JOHN JULIANO, Superintendent, 340 Haven Avenue, New York, New York, advised that the subject currently resides with his wife in Apartment 5S at that address.

On November 27, 1967, PHYLIS PACKER, Secretary, Registrar's Office, Columbia University, advised SA WARREN GORTON, Jr. that the subject is currently registered in the fall term of Teachers College, Columbia University, 525 West 120th Street, as a candidate for a doctorate.

According to Miss PACKER, their files reflect the subject being registered with Columbia University in the following semesters: Spring, 1958; Fall, 1958; Spring, 1959; Fall, 1959; Fall, 1966; Spring, 1967; Summer, 1967. He received

his Master's Degree from Columbia University on February 24, 1960. Upon entrance to Columbia University, his address was listed as 309 West 99th Street, New York City, and his current address is listed as 340 Haven Avenue, New York City. His date of birth is listed as March 17, 1934, in Arlington Heights, Ohio. His wife's name is given as LENNA, and his Faculty Advisor in 1959 was listed as LELAND JACOBS.

According to Miss PACKER, the subject is a candidate for a Doctor of Education degree specializing in Psychology (measurement) and is a student in good standing at this time.

The files of Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), at New York City, reflect that on June 8, 1967, the subject's wife telephonically advised INS that both she and her husband would not consent to any interview by any member of that service.
