On 1/12/61 PCI DANIEL R. VASQUEZ furnished information indicating that the Jefferson Music Company operated by CARLOS MARCELLO'S brother, VINCENT J. MARCELLO, was short changing operators of establishments where Jefferson Music Company had coin operated pinball machines on location. The informant referred specifically to trouble which one SHORTY PLANCHE had in this regard.

On 3/23/61 NO. 1133 was contacted concerning the allegation made by VASQUEZ. NO. 1133 said he had personal knowledge concerning PLANCHE'S dealings with Jefferson Music Company. The informant stated that PLANCHE operated Dee's Lounge in Jefferson Parish along with a partner but they closed the lounge 12/31/60. Informant stated that PLANCHE and his partner formerly had a music box in their place which belonged to Jefferson Music Company. Approximately a year before they closed they had Jefferson Music Company take the box out and they bought their own music box and put it in the lounge. They did this, not because they were dissatisfied with their financial arrangement with Jefferson Music Company, but because they could keep all of the proceeds from the box which they purchased.

NO. 1133 said that PLANCHE was not bothered or intimidated by the Jefferson Music Company or any of its representatives following the removal of the Jefferson Music Company music box. Informant stated that it was not true that PLANCHE and his partner were forced out of Dee's Lounge by
