CRIMINAL INTELLIGENCE PROGRAM NEW ORLEANS DIVISION CARlos

Harry H. Hansen, a potential criminal informant of the New York Division, has advised that Delesseps Morrison, who was recently appointed American Ambassador to the Organization of American States, anticipates entering into an oil scheme with International Time, Inc., a company incorporated under the laws of New York State. Hansen, who is president of this organization, advised this scheme would involve the purchase of a large amount of Venezuelan oil at reduced prices which would be sold for an extensive profit to European countries. This oil would be secured cheaply by virtue of the appointment of Morrison as Ambassador to the Organization of American States. He allegedly will be able to obtain the oil through his contacts in Venezuela.

The supply of oil is owned by the Venezuelan Government and administered by the Bureau of Hydrocarbonaof the Venezuelan Government. Through the intervention of Morrison, Hansen advised a law would be passed by the Venezuelan Government enabling the oil to be sold at \$1.61 a barrel. The posted price for a barrel of oil is currently \$2.50. The oil would be purchased by International Time, Inc., and resold to foreign countries at approximately \$1.66 a barrel. It would remain in South America until sold to foreign governments which would then transport 1: to Europe for refining.

The oil would never be brought to the United States. International Time, Inc., would handle the financing and the profits would be deposited under a number account in a Swiss bank. Hansen advised the sale of the oil would have to be handled in this manner in order to protect Morrison who could possibly be compromised if his participation in this transaction were discovered. Morrison would receive one-half of the profits in these transactions.

Hansen related that on 6/29/61 he was in Attorney James J. Cally's office, 150 Broadway, New York City, where they discussed the above business deal. It was decided that Cally accompanied by one (FNU) Diaz, a Venezuelan national, not
