On 8/25/61, PCI WILLIAM ALBERT BARBRE advised SA ROBERT T. NISCHWITZ of information relative to the gambling set up in Cuba up to the point where FIDEL CASTRO took over control of the island. BARBRE was a 25% owner of the Capri Club in Havana, Cuba at the time.
