HE HAS NOT SEEN SUBJECT SINCE ABOVE INCIDENT AND A WEEK AGO SATURDAY HE CONTACTED JAMES C. LONGO COLUMBIA RESTAURANT WHO ADVISED HIM SUBJECT WAS IN MIAMI. NO ADDRESS ASCERTAINED.
