During the evening of 5/18/61, JAMES U. BURGART, Proprietor of U.U. Burgart Confectionary Store, 956-5th Avo., New Monolagton, Pa., use interviewed for three house in Monroeville, Fa., by SA THOMAS G. FORSYTE, III, and acong other things, BURGARY adviced:

Hip father, VILIMED W. BUMBART, operated the confectionery from approximately 1925 patil his death in 1952 as a numbers-herce book-sports betting station. His father cooperated with the MARMARINOS but was never part of their organization. This was telerated by SAN MARMARINO because he had grown up with WILFRED BURBART and was pseconally fond of him. WILFRED BURBART was the only "independent" allowed to operate in a fachion where he banked his own "play" and only contacted the MANMARINGS to "lay off."

When the elder BUNGART died in 1952, JANUS BURGART took over his business, both legal and illegal, and has operated until the recent past much in the same fachion his father had done. About two years ago, SAN KANNARISO went into scal-retirement and has almost nothing to do with the rackets, leaving this field to his brother, GARNISL KANNARISO, known to BURGART as KELLY MAMMARISO.
