On 5/29/61, PCI JAMES W. BURGART, New Kensington, Pa., advised SA THOMAS G. FORSYTH III:

The MANNARINO controlled horse-room on the second floor at 1195-5th Avenue, New Kensington, receives results from Weirton, W. Va. They have a direct wire to a store in that town which is ostensibly a television repair shop but is actually a race result relay station. The direct wire has an Edison (New Kensington) exchange and is very expensive. Although it is generally known that this horse-room is a MANNARINO operation, it is difficult to say who fronts it for them, because personnel changes are fairly frequent. An attempt will be made to learn the Edison telephone number used in Weirton and the identity of the individual to whom it is billed, believed to be ANDY MANGINI, who holds a Federal Wagering Tax Stamp.
