PSI JERONIMO ESTEVE; JR; (protect); characterized as reliable, advised on 10/11/62, he recently made a trip to Chicago, Washington, D.C., and Miami in connection with his business and Cuban exile activities. During this trip he talked with numerous Cuban exiles, including MIRO CARDONA, in Washington, D.C. and Miami, Florida. Without exception, all contacted were strongly against MANOLO RAY, leader of JURE, and stated they felt that U.S. A. RAY is doing more harm to the Cuban cause than good. also stated no one will support him or his group. also stated that the JURE will fail before it ever gets started because of widespread feeling against RAY and everything he stands/for. (w) ORGANIZALIA

SUBJECT Periodic contact with Cuban sources of the SJO failed to reveal any activity on the part of the JURE in Puerto Rico since its beginning at Juana Diaz and Ponce, Puerto Rico, 9/15 and 16, 1962.
