On 1/21/65, BETSY DUNCAN, PCI, who just returned from an appearance as a singer at the Sands Hotel in Las Vegas advised that she talked to ROSELLI in the Sands Hotel on Christmas Eve at which time he was accompanied by GEORGE PALLAY of New York City. ROSELLI told BETSY that he had driven his car from Los Angeles and PALLAY accompanied him.

DUNCAN said ROSELLI told her that his girlfriend KATHY HORDEN was sick and had to go to a hospital. ROSELLI seemed to want people believe that he and KATHY HORDEN were married.

DUNCAN further advised that on 1/18/65 KATHY HORDEN called her and told her that ROSELLI calls her all the time, cries and wants KATHY to come back to live with him. KATHY said she is afraid of ROSELLI; that she doesn't care for him anymore and that this is why she left him. KATHY said she is not sick and doesn't have to go to a hospital.
