ON JUNE 22, 1964, EVELIO ALPIZAR PEREZ (PROTECT IDENTITY RE REQUEST). A CUBAN PILOT IN EXILE WHO HAS PREVIOUSLY FURNISHED RELIABLE INFORMATION IN CONNECTION WITH ACTIVITIES OF THE MIRR AND SOME PERSONALITIES INCLUDING ITS LEADER. ORLANDO BOSCH. FURNISHED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION.

ON JUNE 22, 1964 ALPIZAR WAS IN CONTACT WITH LAREDO RODRIGUEZ, TREASURER, OF MIRR, WHO TOLD ALPIZAR THE AIR RALD IN WHICH LUIS DIAZ LOPEZ, PILOT, PARTICIPATED OVER CUBA ON JUNE 19, 1964 WAS SPONSORED BY THE MIRR.

RODRIGUEZ TOLD ALPIZAR THAT CONTRARY TO REPORTS GLRCULATED BY CUBAN GOVERNMENT SOURCES, WHERE WAS NO SURVIVORS FROM THE CRASH OF THIS AIRCRAFT. RODRIGUEZ CLAIMED HE HAD CONFIRMED THIS THROUGH HIS SOURCES INSIDE CUBA.

AIRCRAFT WILL LEAVE FROM MIAMI AREA AND FILE A FLIGHT PLAN TO FREEPORT, BAHAMAS. AFTER CHECKING THROUGH CUSTOMS. PLANE WILL FLY TO TREASURE KEY IN UPPER ABACO, BAHAMAS. THE AIRCRAFT WILL THEN DEPART AT ABOUT 5:30 PM AND LAND AT DARK AT MARSH HARBOUR WHERE IT WILL ROUNDEVOUS WITH THE SMALL PLANE. LOADING. THE TWO ENGINE CRAFT WILL LEAVE AT ABOUT 2 AM AND PROCEED TO THE ORIGINAL TARGET WHICH IS THE SUGAR MILL LOCATED NEAR THE CITY OF PUNTA ALEGRE ON NORTH COAST OF CAMAGUEY.

FLYING EXPERIENCE, TOLD ALPIZAR HE AND ANOTHER CUBAN PILOT, NAME NOT DISCLOSED, DURING RECENT PAST, HAD BEEN MAKING PRACTICE RUNS IN A CESSNA AIRCRAFT IN BAHAMA ISLANDS PREPARATORY TO PARTICIPATION IN AIR RADD ON CUBA WITH LUIS DIAZ LOPEZ. THIS INDIVIDUAL TOLD ALPIZAR RAID WAS ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED FOR SUNDAY, JUNE 21, 1964, BUT FOR SOME UNKNOWN REASON, PRESSURE WAS BROUGHT TO BEAR TO CARRY OUT RAID ON JUNE 19, 1964. THE TWO UNIDENTIFIED PILOTS WERE UNABLE TO GO, THEREFORE, THEY WERE REPLACED BY OTHER CREW MEMBERS.

ON JUNE 23, 1964, WILLIAM JOHNSON, PILOT, (PROTECT IDENTITY PER REQUEST), WHO HAS BEEN CHARACTERIZED PREVIOUSLY AS HAVING BEEN INVOLVED IN CUBAN REVOLUTIONARY ACTIVITIES FOR SEVERAL YEARS AND WHO HAS FURNISHED INSUFFICIENT INFORMATION TO EVALUATE HIS RELIABILITY, ADVISED AS FOLLOWS.

ON EVENING OF JUNE 22, 1964, JOHNSON MET WITH ORLANDO BOSCH AT BOSCHS REQUEST. JOHNSON WAS ACCOMPANIED BY FRANK ANTHONY STURGIS, AKA FRANK FIORINI, AMERICAN ADVERTURER AND SOLDIER OF FORTUNE, AND MICHAEL RAFFERTY, JOHNSONS ASSOCIATE IN MIAMI USED CAR BUSINESS.

BOSCH, WHO WAS ACCOMPANIED BY SOME MEMBER OF MIRR, RELATED FOLLOWING: BOSCH SAID AIR RAID OVER CUBA WHICH WAS CARRIED OUT JUNE 19, 1964, WAS AN INDEPENDENT SPUR OF THE MOMENT OPERATION, IN WHICH DIAZ, A MEMBER OF THE MIRR WANTED TO PARTICIPATE.
