ORLANDO BOSCH AVILA, HEAD OF MIRR, AND MESA, IDENTITY UNKNOWN, WERE TRANSPORTING IT BY CAR TRAILER FROM A HOUSE LOCATED ON 29TH AVE, N.W. NEAR 9TH ST., TO COCONUT PGROVE AREA OF MIAMI.

CUSTOMS DESCRIBED TORPEDO AS ABOUT NINE FEET LONG AND TWO FEET IN DIAMETER, CONSTRUCTED FROM A MODIFIED AIRPLANE WING TANK TORPEDO HAD AN OUTBOARD PROPELLER UNDERNEATH AND ON TOP AN ADAPTOR FOR RADIO ANTENNA. ON MAY 12, 1964 STANLEY SCHACHTER, U.S. CUSTOMS MIAMI ADVISED THAT A HOMEMADE TORPEDO HAD BEEN SEIZED BY CUSTOMS AT 9:30 AM SAME DATE AS DR. ORLANDO BOSCH AVILA, HEAD OF MIRR, AND (FNU) MESA, IDENTITY UNKNOWN, WERE TRANSPORTING IT BY CAR TRAILER FROM A HOUSE LOCATED ON 29TH AVE, N.W. NEAR 9TH ST., TO COCONUT GROVE AREA OF MIAMI.
