Attached for Chicago is one copy each of Buairtel
11/1/77 captioned as above and a copy of NYairtels/LHMs
dated 11/15/77 regarding captioned subjects.

FBIHQ and CIAHQ earlier discussed targeting for
recruitment CPUSA members who reside and work in socialist
countries. John Pittman was our initial candidate in view of
his access to the International Department, CC, CPSU.
New York's LHMs were furnished to CIAHQ, and during another
conference held 12/29/77, CIAHQ inquired whether Bureau could
obtain additional assessment of subjects. (X)(u)

Chicago is requested to secure assessment from
CG 5824-OA and submit an LHM suitable for dissemination.
CG 5824-OA should not be advised that the Pittmans are being
targeted for recruitment. Chicago may desire to request the
asset to furnish assessment of various CPUSA members employed
in socialist countries such as Karen Talbot, representative to
the World Peace Council; Phillip Bonosky, USSR correspondent
of the Daily World newspaper, etc. If assessment is obtained
for individuals other than Pittmans, furnish same to FBIHQ under
caption of "CPUSA International Relations." (X)(u)
