7. ROBERT BERNARD BAKER, also known as BARNEY BAKER

ROBERT BAKER is a Teamsters Union organizer, and was observed in 1954 and 1955 in the company of COSTELLO by sources and Bureau Agents. MD

SL T-11 on December 29, 1955 advised on that date that he met with COSTELLO and BAKER in COSTELLO's office. At this time BAKER stated he was interested in SL T-11's scrap venture, and could possibly help him out. SL T-11 related he gave BAKER \$500 on account, and promised him \$5,000 if he, BAKER, could swing a contract for him. It is noted that BAKER was not able to assist informant in this matter, and he did not get a scrap contract.
