MR. WALLACE D. SHANLEY, ASST. US CUSTOMS AGENT IN CHARGE, MIAMI, ON JAN. SIXTEENTH, ADVISED AS FOLLOWS:

AT ABOUT ELEVEN PM ON JAN. FIFTEENTH US CUSTOMS AGENTS ARRESTED ARTHUR ANDREW BERTITE, MARCOS RODRIGUEZ RAMOS, BARBARO BALAN GARCIA, AND CONFISCATED THREE ONE HUNDRED POUND BOMBS, THREE ONE GALLON CANNISTERS OF NAPALM, AND SOME SMALL ARMS. THE ARRESTS AND SEIZURES WERE MADE AFTER THE BOMBS AND NAPALM HAD BEEN LOADED INTO A PAPER APACHE AIRPLANE BEARING REGISTRATION NO. N THREE ZERO ONE FIVE P.

FOR THE INFORMATION OF BUREAU, THE ORIGINAL INFORMATION CONCERNING THIS PROPOSED AIR RAID WAS SUPPLIED BY ^{Potential Security Informant} ~~PSI~~ (UNDER DEVELOPMENT) RAMON OROZCO AND CUSTOMS WAS NOTIFIED. GERTITE, WHO PREVIOUSLY HAD ACTED AS INFORMANT FOR CUSTOMS ORIGINALLY INTENDED NOT TO COOPERATE WITH CUSTOMS ON THIS PARTICULAR MATTER AND DID NOT ADVISE CUSTOMS HE WAS GOING TO FLY THIS RAID. AFTER CUSTOMS WAS ADVISED OF INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM OUR INFORMANT, CUSTOMS WAS ABLE TO AGAIN ASSUME CONTROL OF GERTITE IN ORDER TO ABORT THIS AERIAL ATTACK.

MIAMI WILL FOLLOW AND REPORT PROSECUTION OF THE THREE INDIVIDUALS ARRESTED.
