PCI JOSEPH GRAMBY, PHILADELPHIA BOXING MANAGER, ADVISED THIS DATE COMMON KNOWLEDGE BRUNO CONTROLS ALL PHILADELPHIA AREA RACKET ACTIVITIES AND RUMOR PREVALENT PHILADELPHIA FIGHT CIRCLES THAT GEORGE KATZ, MANAGER OF RECORD SONNY LISTON, HAS GONE TO BRUNO IN EFFORT TO PROTECT HIS LEGALLY ENTITLED TEN PER CENT INTEREST IN LISTON'S FUTURE EARNINGS. THIS CONFIRMS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED MEETINGS BETWEEN KATZ AND BRUNO AT LATTER'S OFFICE BY PH 623 - C\* AND PH 614 - C - TE FOR SAME PURPOSE, IT BEING NOTED KATZ LOANED BRUNO \$5,000. FOR HIS GARDEN STATE VENDING MACHINE COMPANY, MARCH 8, 1962, FOLLOWING INSTANT MEETINGS HELD FEBRUARY, 1962. FURTHER NOTED PH 614 - C - TE REPORTED KATZ CONFERRED WITH BRUNO AT LOCAL LUNCHEONETTE OCTOBER 15.

PH SOURCES REPORT BRUNO INVITED TO SPEND THIS WEEKEND WITH CHARLIE COSTELLO POSSIBLY AT LATTER'S MIAMI WINTER RESIDENCE. BRUNO NOT IN EVIDENCE TODAY AT EITHER RESIDENCE OR PENN JERSEY OFFICE. MIAMI ALERT SOURCE. AM COPY MIAMI.
