On 10/24/62 JOSEPH FRANCIS BORZI advised SA HAROLD H. BOYCE that he is not gambling nor doing anything in violation of the law, and that he spends his full time in the operation of the Brass Rail Bar, a legitimate business.

On 10/26/62 JOE ~~PRENSKY~~ was interviewed by SA HAROLD H. BOYCE relative to the case entitled "JOSEPH FRANCIS ~~CIVELLO~~, aka, AR, OO Dallas" El Paso file 92-85, to determine if this individual had been in El Paso, Texas, or involved in any illegal activity. PRENSKY advised this person was unknown to him and that to his knowledge had never been in El Paso, Texas, or had any connections in El Paso, Texas.
