Synopsis:

MARY and PHILLIE COLUCCI, River Forest, Illinois admit associating with subject's late wife and eldest daughter but deny associating with subject; both deny knowledge that car owned by subject's eldest daughter was registered to their address until car involved in accident. COLUCCI claims not related to COLUCCI brothers who operate handbooks and exercise political influence on Chicago's west side. Subject reportedly seen in company of FRANK SINATRA in Las Vegas. Examination of legal records gives no indication subject has financial interest in Villa Venice, large restaurant and lounge northwest of Chicago. Subject, using name "RUSSELL PAIGE", operated on in May, 1958, for rectal disorder and in April, 1956, for colon disorder, but no indication of malignancy. Subject referred to surgeon by Dr. CARL CHAMPAGNE, brother of ANTHONY V. CHAMPAGNE, notorious hoodlum attorney. Efforts by Deputy United States Marshals during May-July, 1958, to locate subject to serve subpoena for subject's appearance before McClellan Committee unsuccessful to date. Car driven by subject registered to ANTHONY DE BENDO, Berwyn, Illinois, but efforts to establish existence of this person unsuccessful. **ARMED AND DANGEROUS**
