SAMUEL M. GIANCANA, AKA, AR. PCI RANDY BURKE, CONTACTED DAILY RE SUBJECT'S POSSIBLE VISIT NY, ADVISED SUBJECT NOT KNOWN TO BE IN NY AT THIS TIME. JOHN TEETER (PROTECT) ADVISED ON DECEMBER 15 INSTANT SUBJECT NOT IN NY TO HIS KNOWLEDGE. HE RELATED, REFUSING TO NAME HIS SOURCE, THAT SUBJECT AND PHYLLIS MC GUIRE WERE OBSERVED TOGETHER AT KIT KAT CLUB, CHICAGO, ON DECEMBER 2 LAST, AND TO KEEP THIS INFO OUT OF NEWSPAPERS SUBJECT MUST HAVE HAD TO PAY OFF. HE ADDED CHICAGO DAILY NEWS REPORTED PHYLLIS MCGUIRE WITH BILL GOLDBAUM, HER HAIRDRESSER, WHEN IN REALITY SHE WAS WITH SUBJECT. TEETER NAMED GOLDBAUM AS SUBJECT ON MC GUIRE'S MOVEMENTS AND ACTIVITIES. TEETER ALSO STATED HE'D LEARNED FROM HIS UNIDENTIFIED SOURCE THAT CHICAGO DAILY NEWS HAD MADE INQUIRY AT LAS VEGAS RE SUBJECT AND MC GUIRE! ACTIVITIES AND SHERIFF THERE ALLEGEDLY FURNISHED KNOWN DETAILS, THE EXACT NATURE OF WHICH WERE NOT FURNISHED BY TEETER. OPINED SUBJECT AND MC GUIRE ARE BEING VERY CAREFUL TO AVOID PUBLICITY AS SHE HAS RESUMED DATING OLD BOYFRIENDS IN MY.
