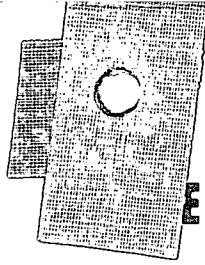

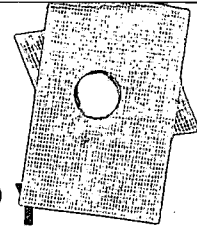

SAMUEL M. GIANCANA, AKA., AR. DAILY SUMMARY.

PCI GEORGE VYDRA ADVISED THAT EXPECTED MEETING AT EXECUTIVE HOUSE, CHICAGO, WITH GIANCANA, THE ENGLISHES, AND PLAZA RECORD COMPANY, SEPTEMBER 18 LAST DID NOT TAKE PLACE; HOWEVER, INFORMANT ADVISED THAT HE ACCOMPANIED SAM ENGLISH TO O'HARE AIRPORT TO PICK UP TWO PLAZA RECORDS REPRESENTATIVES WHO ARRIVED CHICAGO VIA UAL FROM PHILADELPHIA. ALL PROCEEDED TO AMBASSADOR WEST HOTEL. DURING COURSE OF EVENING, ENGLISH ADVISED VYDRA THAT HE AND CHARLES ENGLISH AND SEVERAL "UNKNOWNNS" INVESTED \$331,000 IN DUDE RANCH LOCATED NEAR FLAGSTAFF, ARIZONA. ALSO STATED THAT "THEY" HAVE A "BIG DEAL" GOING IN ACAPULCO, MEXICO; INVITED INFORMANT TO ACCOMPANY HIM THERE NEXT WEEK TO LOOK SITUATION OVER. CG 6512-C-TE HAS ADVISED THAT SYNDICATE HAS SOMETHING GOING IN ACAPULCO, MEXICO. (u)

CG 6486-C\* REPORTED GIANCANA'S PRESENCE SEPTEMBER 18 AND EARLY 19 LAST, HOWEVER, NOT IN VICINITY OF INFORMANT. (u)
