CG 6486-C* REPORTED OVER WEEKEND OF OCTOBER 28 LAST OF PRESENCE OF GIANCANA AND USUAL ASSEMBLAGE OF SIMONELLI, BLASI, JOHN MATASSA, HOWEVER, MOST OF TIME CONSUMED PLAYING CARDS IN BACK ROOM. LARGE GATHERING OF INDIVIDUALS AT SOURCE PRESENT DURING NIGHT OF OCTOBER 29 LAST, NOTED THIS IS DAY ARMORY LOUNGE IS CLOSED. AMONG PERSONS PRESENT WERE GIANCANA, BLASI, BERNARD GLICKMAN (CG 6564-PC). GIANCANA TOOK OFF AGAINST DEMOCRATIC ADMINISTRATION, CRITICIZED PRESIDENT'S HANDLING OF CUBA, STATED IF ADMINISTRATION SPENT LESS TIME ATTEMPTING TO PUT PEOPLE IN JAIL AND MORE ON INTERNATIONAL SITUATION THIS COUNTRY WOULD NOT BE IN ITS PRESENT SHAPE. GIANCANA AND GROUP GOING TO SPORTSMAN'S PARK RACE TRACK INSTANT.
