Surveillances conducted on the subject continue to indicate that he spends a considerable amount of time at his residence working in the yard or garage. Spot surveillances also indicate that the subject continues to visit his brother's liquor store (Aiway Liquor Store) frequently and can usually be observed there during the morning hours.

Regarding the information reported in the details from the Exchange Bank and Trust Company, this information was made available by MR. N. L. LESTER, Senior Vice President.

Regarding the information obtained from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, as mentioned in the details, this information was furnished to SA IVAN D. LEE by JAMES VAUGHN, Area Security Supervisor.

The Dallas Division has developed JOHN BROWN, neighbor of CIVELLO as a confidential source after ascertaining that he was frequently with CIVELLO and a highly regarded executive of the H. L. Hunt Company.

- 1. Will attempt to obtain toll calls from the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company which are charged to the telephone at the residence where the subject resides.
- 2. Will continue to contact informants and sources in an effort to obtain information concerning CIVELLO's activities and contacts.
- 3. Will attempt to make arrangements at the Exchange Bank and Trust Company, 100 Exchange Park North, to review checks issued by the subject; his brother, CHARLES CIVELLO; and his brother-in-law, ROSS MUSSO on a monthly basis.
- 4. Will continue surveillance of subject to cover his activities.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

Surveillances conducted by Bureau Agents continue to indicate that CIVELLO spends a considerable amount of time during the daytime at his residence or at his brother's liquor store (Airway Liquor Store, 3122 West Mockingbird Lane).

It is also noted that ROSS MUSSO, the subject's brother-in-law, who resides at the same residence with CIVELLO, has been spending a considerable amount of time at the liquor store since the first of October, 1965.

It is noted, as in the details, that DL 271-C advised that the subject indicated to him on 11/1/65, that he, the subject, and his wife had been out of Dallas for approximately one week traveling to Rockford, Illinois. This information was verified from the fact that CIVELLO's automobile, a 1964, brown F 85 Oldsmobile was missing from the Dallas area the week of 10/25/65 through 10/29/65.

It is noted that the investigative period is extensive; however, information is included which was received from an auxiliary office subsequent to the dictation of the last report.

B COVER PAGE DL 92-36

The Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, Dallas, Texas, placed in effect in August, 1965, a ruling that they will only release information concerning toll calls after being served with a subpoena duces tecum. At the present time, JAMES VAUGHN, a former Bureau Agent, and presently a Special Agent for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, Dallas, has indicated he would be willing to furnish the toll calls on a limited number of hoodlums in the Dallas area to the FBI without being served with a subpoena. It is requested that this be kept to a minimum of individuals.

Regarding the records of the Exchange Bank and Trust Company as mentioned in the details, information was furnished by MR. LEON HENSLEY, Vice President.

- 3. Will continue to conduct surveillances of JOSEPH CIVELLO and surveillances at the Airway Liquor Store in an effort to determine the visitors to the liquor store of Italian extraction. Will also be alert for any information which may lead to the development of a possible source to be used in the CIVELLO investigation. Attempt to ascertain the individuals of Italian extraction who are in close contact with the subject or his brother, CHARLES CIVELLO, or brother-in-law, ROSS MUSSO.
- 4. Will conduct further background information concerning individuals telephonically contacted by CIVELLO as set forth in the details of this report.
