Mr. French requested that the information be summari the same manner as in three previous letterhead memo (dated 11/7,8, and 12/63) containing information from same source. Mr. French had previously requested the Meissner's identity be concealed because of the confibasis upon which the information had been furnished by Meissner and the sensitive nature of the matter if the Department was seeking Meissner's cooperation, put the possibility of an attempt to influence the judge in the forthcoming trial of James R. Mr. French advised that on 11/22/63 Meissner would be telephonic contact with French or Department Attorned McKeon at Detroit, and it would be known whether Ver had confirmed arrangements to meet Meissner in Chica 11/25/63. Mr advised on 11/22/63 that no further word had been reby him from Meissner regarding the proposed meeting Verhelle on 11/25/63. Inasmuch as the Bureau has advised in reairtel that the LHM will be disseminated only to the Criminal Division of the Department, there is no known reason for Meissner's identity to be concealed, other than Mr. French's original request, as mentioned above. Mr. French probably will not be available at Detroit for further discussion of this point prior to next week. If the Bureau desires to withhold dissemination of the LHM until that time, it will be determined from him whether there is any objection at this time to disclosing Meissner's identity in the LHM, and if there is no objection by him, an amended LHM will be submitted immediately. Otherwise it is believed the LHM could be disseminated in its present form.

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
