PCI LOWELL WILLIAMSON has not been in NYC since November, 1963. Information was received 12/16/63 that WILLIAMSON was at that time in Calgary, Canada.

For the information of the Chicago Office, on 12/16/63, MURRAY KANE, Manager of the MC GUIRE sisters, was interviewed by agents of the NYO in connection with the theft of furs from DOROTHY and CHRISTINE MC GUIRE while they were in Boston in November, 1963.

KANE advised DOROTHY was in Calgary, CHRIS in Fort Lauderdale, Florida and PHYLLIS at 525 Park Avenue, NYC. KANE contacted PHYLLIS MC GUIRE in an attempt to arrange an interview with the agent concerning this theft and she advised KANE that she did not have anything stolen from her, and as she knew nothing concerning the theft she did not desire to be interviewed.

The NYO will, when WILLIAMSON returns to NYC, determine if he feels the time is appropriate for an interview of PHYLLIS MC GUIRE.
