NOTE:

The informant is Meyer "Mike" Singer, former Teamsters Union official in Los Angeles, who furnished this information to our Los Angeles Office on an extremely confidential basis. Our files contain no pertinent information concerning Earl Scheib; Earl Scheib Paint Shops; or Frank A. Hatfield.

Anthony Doria is a labor racketeer, who was kicked out of the AFL-CIO in 1957. He reportedly is the "behind-the-scenes" man in two independent labor unions which were organized in Los Angeles in 1958. Doria has been reported in the past as being close to Hoffa. Dick Kavner is an international organizer of the Teamsters Union, who has been reported as working directly under both Hoffa and Harold J. Gibbons, Executive Vice President of the Teamsters Union. Kavner was indicted in St. Louis, Missouri, in 1954, for violating the Anti-Racketeering Statute, but this indictment later was dismissed without prosecution. (92-1100)

The field has been instructed to undertake an immediate, thorough investigation in this case.
