TEEMER held by police in Mexico City, Mexico, on 1/22/58 and then escorted to a plane and returned to U.S. Was managing a gambling casino at Mexico City at time. Does not contemplate returning. He was in Pittsburgh during February and again in March, 1958. Interviewed by Agents 3/17/58. Furnished considerable information re his activities in Cuba, Mexico City, and in connection with Club 30. Is attempting to arrange for Club 30 to re-open. Expects to manage a gambling casino in Havana, Cuba, if unable to operate Club 30.
