On 11/26/62 representative of Department of Army confidentially advised that Army has no operational interest per se in Alpha 66 as organization. However, he indicated that Army has used some of its members and leaders as sources of information. (S)

Army representative stated Army has used Eloy Gutierrez Menoyo as "casual" source of information since about July, 1961, although Menoyo has produced little information of value. Army considers Menoyo to be of unproven reliability. According to Army representative, Menoyo has not been used by Army in any operational capacity; however, Menoyo claims to be head of Second Front of Escambray, an anti-Castro exile group, and claims to have capability of moving arms and ammunition in and out of Cuba. Army is not sold on Menoyo's authenticity and, as a matter of fact, based on his background and information furnished by us, above-mentioned Army representative is of opinion that Menoyo may be pro-Castro rather than anti-Castro. Army, however, is continuing to accept any information Menoyo may volunteer. (S)
