PCI TRILCK advised on 6/1/63 that he had only met ANTHONY GIACALONE on one occasion. He stated that ANTHONY and VITO GIACALONE were introduced to him several months ago by AMOS BOTTIS. He stated that BOTTIS owned a building in which there was a pool hall on West Jefferson in Ecorse, Michigan, and that BOTTIS had rented the upstairs of this hall to the two GIACALONE brothers where they intended to operate a barbute game. He stated that from the conversation he had with BOTTIS the two GIACALONE brothers were the men who would run the barbute game.
