On Sunday, 1/12/64, spot checks were made by SAA LEON F. ANDREWS, JR., of the homes, hangouts and the West Side Buffalo areas where members of the "MAGADDINO Family" are known to frequent, without locating New York License UT 4408 previously observed on car driven by SAM GRIO.

On 1/12/64, BU 280-C* reported that subject visited the Magaddino Memorial Chapel that day and gave no indication he was planning to meet anyone that day.

On 1/12/64, BU 258-C* reported that FRED G. RANDACCIO and his brother, VICTOR RANDACCIO, visited FRED S. MCGAVERO that day. BU 258-C* reported no information that RANDACCIO was expecting anyone from out of town to meet in Buffalo that day.

In view of the absence of information as to the time and mode of travel from Utica to Buffalo, no further inquiries were made by the Buffalo Office.

It is noted that Mrs. ROBERT H. JENSON, PCI, and next door neighbor of the MAGADDINO family, Town of Lewiston, N.Y., advised that there were no strange cars observed at the homes of STEVE MAGADDINO, JAMES V. LA DUCA, CHARLES A. MONTANA and VINCENT A. SCRO on 1/12/63.
